Packing Tips

1. Make a priority list and pack according to the list.
2. First Things First. Give high priority to Documents.
3. **Get TSA Locks or Bags with attached TSA locks (Very Important!!)**
4. **Get a prescription for all the medicines. Keep copies in each bag and original in hand baggage.**
5. **Keep PDF copies of all documents on the phone and cloud.**
6. **Create a copy of the set of documents and keep it in all bags.**
7. Avoid getting pulses, rice, dal, flour, seeds etc. as they might create an issue during the customs and immigration section.
8. For Fragile items, wrap it with clothes.
9. Remove the tags from new dress/clothes.
10. Insert clothes and dress into empty vessels if you are running out of space.
11. Tie a colorful ribbon on the suitcase handle. Makes it easy to identify your suitcase in the baggage claim area.
12. Put identification marks and labels outside the bags apart from this, the airlines will also provide you with adhesive labels.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Airport Pickups

One of the services offered by the Indian Students Association (ISA) is Airport Pickups for Incoming Students. We would be having airport pick-ups for Fall '21 students as well. We will try to provide airport pick-ups for as many students as possible but cannot guarantee this service for every incoming student. The students being selected for this service would be on a random basis and we will try to provide pick-ups for maximum number of students. Students just need to fill out the pick-up forms rolled out by ISA and if he/she is selected for the pick-up, ISA would reach out to him/her regarding the process to be followed next.

2. Health Insurance

Health Insurance is a mandatory thing in the US.

Since health expenses are very costly in the US it is highly recommended by the university to get insurance.

UTD insurance is quite costly because it covers everything related to an individual's health. It is highly recommended to take university insurance and even though you can try third-party insurance you should make sure UT-Dallas's requirements are met and the university should approve the third-party insurance or else you won't be allowed to enroll in any courses.

3. Hold on Account?

To check your hold information:

- a. Log in to the Galaxy portal.
- b. Select Orion Self-Service.
- c. Click "Student Center."

There are many categories in which student accounts can be kept on hold.

- i. Official Transcripts/Degree Certificate Hold: Students must send the Official transcripts along with the University degree certificate Photocopy to UTD.

This hold can be temporarily removed for one semester by emailing the Admissions Office to enroll for the classes.

- ii. TB Test Hold: Students must get tested for TB before attending any event on On-campus, take a buffer of at least 1 week for TB test and attend Orientation Online if possible.
- iii. Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination Hold: Entering students 22 years of age or older by the first day of class for the semester are exempt.

4. To Open Bank Account:

Check for the banks based on minimum deposit criteria and maintaining balance for Student Account. BB&T and PNC banks do not have minimum balance & direct deposit criteria.

Rest all banks like Chase, BoFA & Wells Fargo have minimum balance & direct deposit Criteria.

Documents Required are Passport, Visa, I-20.

5. Housing

"Off campus housing available on East and west side of campus. UTD shuttle runs on both sides with 30 min frequency on East and 12 min frequency on west from morning 7 AM to evening 11 PM during weekdays. Shuttle runs with 30 min frequency on Saturday and Sundays.

Communities on west sides are Courtyard at Campbell, Ashwood Park, Pearl and Estates on Frankford, Palencia, Chatham Court and on East sides are Northside, Estates of Richardson, Marquis, and Pradera.

Average rent for 1b1b apartment is \$750 - \$1500 and for 2b2b apartment is \$1200 - \$2250. You can connect with respective communities via email.

If you are sharing a room then per person rent will be between \$300 to \$500 plus utilities (Electricity, Water, Internet) depending upon apartment and community. You can add up to \$150 for other living expenses.

You will receive a non-furnished apartment. Before you move into an apartment you must pay a deposit if asked, set up electricity and insurance, sign lease papers, few communities might ask you to pay rent in advance. You can use a forex card, Credit card or international debit card to pay an amount from India. Community manager will not provide you with keys if any of this is pending.

Check if all the electricity switches and water taps are working and let the community manager when you enter the apartment.”
